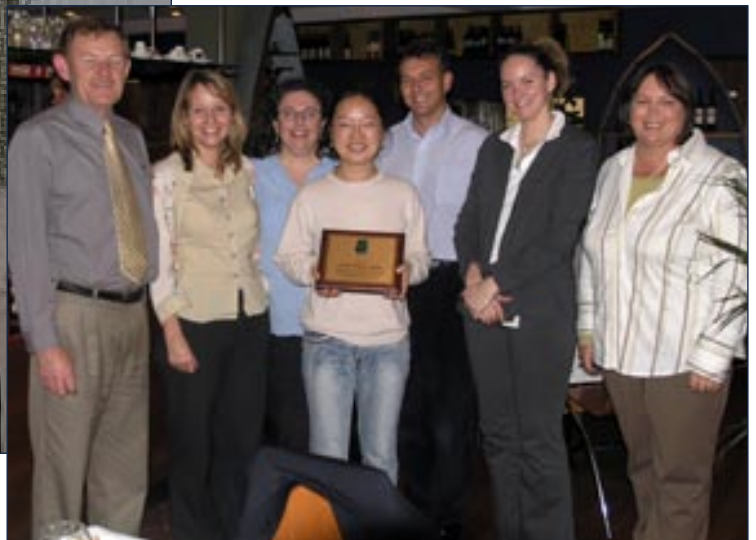
## Congratulations to ACCESS programs Australia
